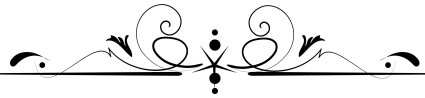
Valley View News

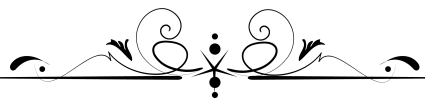
